3. A 她变成了一个非常无聊的(boring)人。

5. D 让人几乎无法(impossible)面对的是,在事故发生的前一天,Kerry 拜访了她的朋友,并全程批评她对男友的选择(choice)、她的生活方式、她与母亲的关系以及她认为需要表达(express)的各种其他事情。

7. B 见第 5 题解析。
8. A 直到她的朋友受到严重伤害,Kerry 才意识到(aware of)她吹毛求疵的习惯。很快,她学会了珍惜生活,而不是如此严厉地评判(judge)一切。
9. B 见上题解析。
10. D 她也能把她的新智慧转移到她生活(life)的其他方面。
11. C 也许我们大多数人在吹毛求疵方面并不极端,但是当我们诚实的时候,我们可以对这个世界进行尖锐的(sharply)批评。
12. A 我并不是建议你忽略(ignore)问题,或者假装事情比它们更好(better),只是建议你学会让事情顺其自然——至少在大多数时候,尤其是当这没什么大不了(deal)的时候。

14. C 见第 12 题解析。
15. D 训练自己“咬紧牙关”,通过一些实践(practice),你会变得善于释怀。
16. C 细节理解题。根据第三段“Competing in the event helps students improve their spelling, increase their vocabularies and develop self-confidence.”可知,Scripps National Spelling Bee 大赛有助于提高学生的拼写能力、增加词汇量以及发展自信。
17. B 推理判断题。根据第一段“M-U-R-R-A-Y-A is the word that pushed Zaila Avant-garde, 15, to victory in the 2021 Scripps National Spelling Bee. The annual event took place in July, 2021, in Florida.”及第四段“She studied for two years. ‘I worked with a tutor and studied some days up to seven hours,’ she said.”可推断,Zaila 是在 13 岁开始为拼写大赛做准备的。
18. D 细节理解题。根据第七段“The rising star is not finished. She has big goals for the future. ‘I’d like to play basketball at Harvard, play in the WNBA, become a head coach in the WNBA, and work for NASA,’ she said.”可知,Zaila 的理想之一就是在 WMBA 当教练。

19. A 推理判断题。根据最后一段“After receiving a copy of *the Guinness Book of World Records* on her eighth birthday, she set her sights on becoming a record holder. ‘When I looked in the book,’ she said, ‘I decided that I wanted to be in it.’ Now, at the age of 15, Zaila holds three world records.”可推断,在看过《吉尼斯世界纪录》这本书后,她开始想成为纪录保持者。
20. C 推理判断题。根据第二段中“Accompanied only by her dog Charlie, she survived cold weather and meetings with polar bears. In fact, Charlie saved her life when one of them attacked her.”可知, C 项正确。
21. A 细节理解题。根据文章第三段中“Helen goes to challenging places not only for adventure, but also for education.”可知,我们得知她旅游不仅是为了冒险,更为了教育。
22. D 推理判断题。根据倒数第二段的“They hope to travel in mainland China into Sichuan and Tibet to study pandas this year.”可知,他们希望去中国大陆的四川和西藏旅游。
23. A 标题判断题。Helen Thayer 去北极、撒哈拉大沙漠等条件极其有挑战性的地方旅游,由此可知她是个爱探险的女人。
